**1. CALL TO ORDER:**

**Mayor McCarthy called the meeting to order at 6:04 p.m.**

**2. APPROVE AGENDA**

Council Member Bluesky suggested discussing item 5D when Council Member Armstrong joined the meeting, as he is only able to be present for part of the meeting due to a previous commitment.

**M/S/P (McCarthy / Bulera) to approve the June 15, 2020 Agenda as amended.**

**Roll call vote: McCarthy aye; Bulera aye; Bluesky aye; Ludwig aye. Motion passed 4-0; Armstrong absent.**

**3. CONSENT AGENDA**

Council Member Bulera asked that Consent Item C be removed for additional discussion.

**M/S/P (Bulera / Bluesky) to approve Consent Agenda Items A, B, and D as presented. Roll call vote: McCarthy aye; Bulera aye; Bluesky aye; Ludwig aye.**

**Motion passed 4-0; Armstrong absent.**

Consent Agenda Item C – Council Member Bulera noted Planning Commission Minutes not approved and wondered why included. City Attorney Sandstrom confirmed draft minutes available for reference only.

*Council Member Armstrong on-line (6:09)*

**3a. City Clerk / Administrator Engstrom – Beach Patrol/Parking Options (see Item 5D below)**

City Clerk/Administrator Engstrom reported complaints received from residents Janet Simonsen, Cindie Reiter, and others relative to last Monday's beach attendance and related parking and no social distancing; large signs have been ordered stating 'Beach

Parking Full' to be placed near St. Croix Trail and 20<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, and possibly other areas along with signs on and near the beach with the non-emergency number for the Washington County Sheriff; inquiries have also been made regarding hiring an off-duty officer to assist with crowd management (4 hr. minimum at cost of \$80/hour); an ordinance is in place and ticket books printed to issue tickets for parking violations; asked City Attorney Sandstrom to comment on closing the beach. City Attorney Sandstrom verified the City can't restrict beach access to residents only as it is a public beach. Council Member Bulera suggested permitting, when needed, City leaders or attendants to walk the area and provide informational guidance and crowd control – being a responsible part of the solution and support for Bob Shearer and the deputy. Remedies were discussed as well as the one week notice for hiring an off-duty officer, traffic control, parking. Mayor McCarthy called the question.

**M/S/P (Mayor McCarthy / Council Member Bluesky) to delegate authority to the City Clerk/Administrator to contract with Washington County an off-duty officer to assist with beach management when necessary at a cost of \$80/hour for 4 hours minimum [\$320]. By roll call, Mayor McCarthy, Council Member Armstrong, Council Member Bluesky, Council Member Bulera, and Council Member Ludwig voted aye. Approved 5-0.**

Consensus of Council that Mayor McCarthy should call a special/emergency meeting to respond and address any issues promptly if it is deemed necessary to close the beach. Per City Attorney Sandstrom, signs would need to be posted and enforced, along with a formal resolution how/why they are closing the beach, so that all understand the beach closed.

#### **4. PUBLIC SAFETY REPORTS**

##### **A. Law Enforcement –**

Mayor McCarthy reported there were 51 ICRs in the City in May 2020, with 8 parking citations issued.

##### **B. Emergency Response and Fire -**

Mayor McCarthy reported 3 incidents in Lake St. Croix Beach during May 2020. No questions regarding Lower St. Croix Valley Fire Protection District Financial Reports of May 2020.

##### **C. Animal Control –**

Council Member Bulera reported no activity for May 2020.

#### **5. CITY STAFF REPORTS**

##### **A. City Treasurer Report (*Supplemental Claims distributed 6.15.2020*)**

1. Accountant Mary Paul provided a statement of operations for May 2020 noting significant receipts [Building Permit Fees \$1,239 and Gaming Revenue \$546] and expenses [Washington County 2020 Assessment Fees \$7,798, SEH \$7,040 and Levee Repair \$40,000] for the month.

**M/S/P (Bluesky / Bulera) to approve the total Claims to be Approved: May 19, 2020 through June 15, 2020 of \$70,137.59 [Check 18558, 18768-18786, and EFT/Direct Deposits 200601-200625] as presented. Roll call vote: McCarthy aye; Bulera aye; Bluesky aye; Ludwig aye. Motion passed 4-0; Armstrong absent.**

**B. City Engineer Parotti**

**1. Quinlan Update**

City Engineer Parotti provided work on Quinlan will likely begin in July after a contractor for CenterPoint Energy replaces and relocates gas mains in the same area as the City project; some challenges have occurred in crews access to entering homes due to COVID.

**2. Bluffline Stabilization**

Grant funding to continue the section of 13<sup>th</sup> Street; project restoration will be on top of riprap; WMO plantings above riprap. Still in design phase for construction after September 1, 2020; working with WMO and staff on engineering drawings that will be available mid-July

**C. City Attorney Sandstrom**

City Attorney remarked on Resolution passed on March 16, 2020, maintaining the City Hall closed to the public until further notice due to COVID, that if Council wishes to begin meeting in person with social distancing, that there are still other issues that need to be addressed; staff has protocols - measurements of City Hall have been taken in chambers (City Council meetings) and alternative options researched (plexiglass partitions). Discussion on utilizing a location change or conducting outdoors.

*City Attorney Sandstrom suggested keeping this an agenda item for some level of discussion until further notice.*

**E. Deputy Clerk/Treasurer – Clean-Up Day Update**

Total receipts were \$4,184; Lake St. Croix Beach participation 36.8%, Lakeland 58.4%, and Lakeland Shores 4.8%; thanks extended to Council Member Bulera for all of her help that morning, Mayor McCarthy, Teens for Christ, and Jim Stanton. The day was a success and many items able to be recycled.

**Council Member Bluesky** –

- Assisted a resident in taking her used batteries to the Washington County Waste Site; suggested article for newsletter if someone is looking for help to call City Hall.
- Wanted to know who is authorized to use ticket books mentioned during beach discussion; understands the City had a code enforcement officer but feels if they have books available, authorized personnel with authority should be documented.

**Council Member Ludwig** – no report

**Council member Bulera** –

- On Memorial Day, spraying was done in Riverfront Park by Lawn Barbers; has been asking for details on applying chemicals; doesn't believe it a good practice and concerned; need to let the public know. City Clerk/Administrator Engstrom has talked with the owner and contract found under Public Works; they have agreed to notify the City prior to spraying that was actually done by a sub-contractor Lawn Doctors; had City Engineer review and there were no concerns and no direct spray to the River. Consensus made to discontinue lawn treatments at Riverfront Park.
- Erosion on 16th/17th Street to stairs – would like to consider rock or split rail fence so not used for trail. Council Member Bluesky and Mayor McCarthy advised this was a Washington County emergency deployment area that is used when transporting to ambulance from River.
- Requesting additional trash bins in beach area, 6 versus 3.
- Wants to do a good job as a Council Member; City has a 5-person team and she is disheartened as part of the team she is not notified of issues [if issues arise, all Council should be told immediately of the issue so they can answer resident concerns].

**Mayor McCarthy** –

- Governor Tim Walz has directed all flags at state and federal buildings in Minnesota to be flown at half-staff from sunrise to sunset on the 19th of every month through 2020 to remember, mourn, and honor lives lost due to COVID-19; he will be lowering flags on June 19<sup>th</sup>.
- Reminder to residents to trim foliage on rights-of-way if there is overgrowth so intersections are safe and clear.

Dave,

I've reviewed the pictures of the levee mowing. I recommend that the City follow the vegetation management practices as required by the US Army Corps of Engineers' *Levee Owner's Manual for Non-Federal Flood Control Works* (Public Law 84-99). That document covers mowing and weed control on pages 16 & 17 (attached). The requirements are summarized as follows:

1. Keep grasses mowed such that growth does not exceed 12" in height
2. Mow to a minimum height of 3"
3. Last mowing of the season should be accomplished to allow grass to grow to 8-10 inches by the winter season
4. Mow entire profile, including zones extending 15 feet beyond the toe which should be free of all woody growth



If the requirements of 84-99 are not adhered to, the City risks losing Us Army Corps funding assistance which is available in the event of levee damage.

If you need any further assistance with this, please let me know.

## 2.8 Vegetation (Levee Specific)

The Corps' policy for landscaping around levees, floodwalls, and embankment dams, is found in EM 1110-2-301. The requirements are sometimes seen as being excessive and out of touch with contemporary environmental concerns, but as the primary function of a levee is to protect communities from flooding, the Corps' maintenance requirements have been established to reduce the chance of catastrophic failures during high water. If you'd like a variance to the Corps' vegetation requirements (allowing additional vegetation on or around the levee) then you need to contact your local Corps district. A variance would be granted if the proposed vegetation is seen to preserve, protect, or enhance natural resources, or if it protects the rights of Native Americans. Such variances will only be granted if the vegetation retains the safety, structural integrity, and functionality of the levee; retains the accessibility for inspection and flood fighting purposes; and doesn't reduce the level of protection required by the National Flood Insurance Program or the RIP if the levee is a part of these programs. Specific items relating to the maintenance of levee vegetation include the maintenance of the grass or sod cover and the removal of unwanted bushes and trees.

### a. Maintaining and Promoting a Good Grass or Sod Cover

Grass or sod cover is one of the most effective and economical means of protecting flood control levees and drainage swales against erosion caused by rain runoff, channel flows, and wave wash. As the public sponsor, you are required to ensure the grass cover has every opportunity to grow. This will require that you periodically fertilize, water, and mow the grasses as needed. In addition, every effort must be made to prevent unauthorized encroachments, grazing, vehicle traffic, the misuse of chemicals, or burning during inappropriate seasons. Failure to properly maintain the grass cover can result in unnecessary erosion and possible embankment failure.



**Figure 2.29** *MINIMALLY ACCEPTABLE.* This photo shows cattle grazing on the levee. Cattle typically don't harm the sod cover to the extent that sheep or other animals do. In this case, the landowner and the public sponsor were informed of the Corps' policy that grazing is not permitted on levees or within the levee easement area.

### b. Mowing

Periodic mowing is essential to maintaining a good ground cover. Levees should be mowed regularly in order to control weeds and to prevent the growth of brush and saplings. Long grasses and native prairie grasses are one of the many challenges facing the project inspector. Long grasses (greater than 12 inches in length) can make a visual inspection nearly impossible and can hide serious concerns such as rodent activity, levee slides, and cracking; all of which can lead to the failure of the levee. For these

reasons, the grass should be mowed to a minimum height of 3 inches. The last mowing of the season should be accomplished under conditions that will allow the grass to grow to approximately 8 to 10 inches by the winter season. It's important to ensure that the entire levee profile has been mowed, including zones extending 15 feet beyond the toes of the embankment, which should be free of all woody growth and should be clear of other obstructions so that a truck could drive beside the levee if needed.

### c. Control of Trees, Brush, and Weeds

If the public sponsor mows the levee at regular intervals, the growth of saplings, trees, and brush will not become a problem. However, if the levee is not mowed regularly, the resulting growth will make it difficult to properly maintain and inspect the project. Trees and brush can also affect the stability of the structure and interfere with emergency operations during high-water conditions. All trees and brush must be cleared and disposed of away from the flood control project. The disposal of material on the riverward side of the levee or areas where flood waters can carry the material downstream is prohibited. In riprap protected areas, ditches, or in other areas of the project where power mowing is impractical, the unwanted vegetation should be controlled with an approved herbicide spray or should be cut by hand. Herbicides must be used in accordance with state and local laws and regulations. Any trees that reach 2 inches in diameter or greater, and are located on the levee, riprapped areas, drainage channels, or within 15 feet of the toe of the levee must be cut down, the root ball removed, the voids filled with impervious material, and the fill material firmly compacted and reseeded.




Figure 2.32 UNACCEPTABLE long grasses and trees on levee side slopes. (ND)

## An Ordinance Amending Watercraft Permit Requirements Summary

The City has seen that there have been vacant sailboat permits for the past few years. At the same time, there are residents on a waiting list for a power boat permit.

The City's permit from the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers (COE) allows for 35 watercraft. The COE does not care how the permits are issued as it relates to the type of watercraft. It was MN DNR staff that had asked that permits be for 18 power boats and 17 sailboats. No compelling reason for this distinction was given.

The Park Commission's Permit and Legal Committee, including the City Attorney, researched this issue. They reviewed federal, state and local rules and laws on this topic. It was determined that there is NOT a rule or law that would require the City to apportion some of its permits to sailboats.

To better serve the needs of residents, the Park Commission recommends that the City Watercraft Ordinance be amended to remove the current restriction and to allow permit holders to choose their boat type.

The Park Commission suggests the attached document and asks for City Council permission to hold a public hearing on this proposed ordinance amendment.

Research materials are on file at City Hall.

Hello Dave and Linda,

I am responding to your below email. I did review the attached outline of information from the Parks Commission/Linda last week as well as Linda's message to me on last Friday to discuss the same. I did review the memo and found the analysis by the Parks Committee/Linda very helpful, but was also interested in conducting a little bit of additional research of my own. In particular, I thought it was important to review the DNR's administrative rules that were promulgated pursuant to the Lower St. Croix Wild and Scenic Riverway Act to see if there was any rules or guidance on requirements to favor sailboats over motorboats. Those rules are found at Minnesota Admin. Rules chapter 6105.

Rule 6105.0210 relates to promulgation of local rules and restrictions on the use of public and private lands on the river, and in particular, Subpart 3 provides: "Water surface zoning. Any regulations which

may be necessary to reduce conflicts among users of a particular river, or between users and nearby residents, shall be promulgated as part of the management plan for the river, or as amendments thereto. The boundaries of such areas shall be described with particularity in the management plan." That rule does NOT require any particular apportionment of boat permits.

Rules 6105.0300 to 6105.0350 relate in particular to the surface use of the Lower St. Croix. It contains the rules relating to existing slow/no wake zones for motorboats and restrictions on water skiing at night or in slow/no wake zones. Although the speed restrictions do not apply to sail-powered boats and therefore would seemingly favor sailboats, there is NOT a rule that would require the City to apportion some of its permits to sailboats.

Finally, Rule 6105.0410 relates to establishing Marinas. The city's issuance of public boat permits does not appear to necessarily fit the definition of a "marina" in the rules, but regardless, the rules on marinas do NOT require any apportionment of use towards sailboats.

In short, I do not find anything in the DNR's rules that would mandate the City to continue holding a certain number of its permits open for sailboats. That, in conjunction with the fact the new DNR rep seems to intend to take a hands-off approach to the DNR's regulation of the St. Croix River, it appears permissible to me for the City to revise its ordinances to allow any type of boat for its boat permits.

Regarding procedure, given that this rule exists in City Code, it will be necessary to engage in an ordinance amendment to make the revision. In general, public hearings are only required for a change to a zoning-related ordinance. However, there is a specific DNR Rule 6105.0530 that appears to require a public hearing for any adoption or amendment to local code/ordinance relating to the St. Croix Riverway. Therefore, a public hearing notice should be published and

public hearing should be held. The Rule does not specify who holds the hearing, so I suppose it could be either the Parks Commission or the Council itself. The procedure would be a formal written recommendation from the Parks Commission and consideration of the same by the Council. This should be done in the form of a written proposed Ordinance that amends the Code as necessary.

I have attached a sample Ordinance amending the City Code regarding a minor leash law change made by LSCB from a couple of years ago. This would be the type of format that the Parks Commission and City Council should use to consider this change.

The draft proposed ordinance should be put together in advance of the public hearing so that the public can read the draft in advance of providing their public input.

Note that the Rules also provide for advance review and input from the DNR, county or city planning commission, regional planning commission, and Minnesota-Wisconsin Boundary Area Commission. Rule 6105.0530, subp. 3. However, as recently discussed in conjunction with the extension of the Riley variance, it is highly doubtful this step is required, given that the DNR no longer seems to have much authority or say over local decisions regarding the riverway, and the fact that the MN-WI Boundary Area Commission was disbanded almost 20 years ago.

Research on Power vs. Sail Boat Distinction

### History

5/1/1974. Per Section 504.02 of the Lower St. Croix River Bluffland and Shoreland Ordinance “existing uses that were permitted prior to 5/1/1974 may again be allowed upon approval by the MN DNR.” (The City had no restriction on the type of watercraft at that time.)

6/16/1983. LSCB Ordinance No. 91. “Permits for a maximum of 35 watercraft will be given in any year. Permits may be issued for no more than 18 motorboats, the remaining watercraft shall all be sailboats.”

The federal law designating the St. Croix National Scenic Riverway does not speak to distinguishing power vs. sailboats. The MN DNR staff asked for this distinction in 1983.

10/27/1992. Comments from Ms. Judy Kolb, Corps of Engineers regarding LSCB permit. “The COE does not care how the 35 permits are issued as it relates to the type of boat. The city can decide if it wants to distinguish between power boats and sailboats.”

### Today – 2020

Although residents want boat permits, for several years the City cannot issue all of the 35 permits because of the power vs. sail limitation. Currently there are 8 vacant sailboat permits and 15 people on a waiting list for a power boat permit.

May 20, 2020

Research on power vs. sail performance on the water.

It was mentioned that in 1983 the MN DNR staff may have thought that sailboats were less of an impact on the water than power boats. Understand that there are a variety of boat hulls, lengths and motor types. I made a comparison of the performance of two typical recreational boats.

1. Boat Speed – quite similar.

A J70 sailboat can reach 20 knots or 23 MPH.


A 20ft. Pontoon boat with a 40 hp motor can reach 16-25 MPH.

2. Use of the River – sailboat uses more water surface.

With a head wind, a sailboat will cover approximately twice as much area than a power boat traveling in a straight line in the same direction.

Sailing upwind requires consideration of several factors, including wind speed, wave conditions and level of comfort desired. In the example above, any of the three routes shown will lead to the same destination.

Permit and Legal Committee May 28, 2020

Present: Nicole Runge, Linda O'Donnell, Karen Riley, Dave ~~Engstrom~~ and Kate Piscatello.

Notes:

Members reviewed researched documents on the City's Corps of Engineers Permit for 35 watercraft.

There was discussion that there continues to be a waiting list of residents wanting power boat permits. The City is unable to issue all of its 35 permits because of the limitation of 18 power and 17 sailboat types.

There was discussion on the power vs. sail distinction.

- This distinction was imposed on the City by MN DNR. This distinction was not imposed on all of the marinas and launch ramps on the St. Croix River.
- There was no compelling reason found for the City to continue this distinction.

It was recommended to submit research material to Attorney Kevin Sandstorm for his comments and suggestions on how to proceed if the City wishes to amend Ordinance 900 to remove the power vs. sail limitation as it relates to the City's 35 boat permits.

## Linda's Comments

Over the years, City Councils have shown no desire to distinguish between power vs. sail.

It appears that the MN DNR was inconsistent by arbitrarily imposing the power vs. sail restrictions on LSCB.

It has been 37 years since LSCB had to make the power vs. sail distinction. Interest in the sport of sailing has diminished. As a sailor for over 45 years, I know that sailing requires a whole set of skills not needed for power boating. The ability to safely sail is, among other things, weather driven. If there is no wind, you can't sail. If it is very windy, it might not be safe to sail. But, a power boat can operate in a greater range of conditions.

Technology has improved the environmental impact of power boating with cleaner fuel and more efficient motors.

I would recommend that the City amend Ordinance No. 91 by removing the power boat and sailboat limitations on the City's 35 watercraft permits.

900 WATERCRAFT REGULATION

901. LICENSING AND REGULATION OF THE MOORING OF WATERCRAFT, USE OF PRIVATE BOAT DOCK SLIPS OR OTHER HOISTS ON CITY SHORELAND

901.010. In order to assure the orderly use of the City's shoreland designated parkland, the mooring of watercraft or the use of private boat docks, slips or hoists will be limited to residents of the City of Lake St. Croix Beach, and will require a permit to be issued by the City Council on an annual basis. Permits for a maximum of 35 watercraft will be given in any year. Permits may be issued for no more than 18 motorboats, the remaining watercraft shall be sailboats.

A. A "motorboat" means any boat propelled exclusively by an internal combustion engine.

B. A "sailboat" means any boat intended to be propelled primarily by the wind. It may be equipped with a motor for auxiliary use.

C. Each permit will be subject to yearly review before renewal is considered. A person who receives a permit is entitled to moor or dock one watercraft registered in that person's name. Only one permit will be granted to any one household. Annual permit fees shall be established from time to time by resolution of the City Council.

901.020. An applicant must submit a mooring/docking application by March 31 of each year to the City Clerk/Treasurer, accompanied with the designated fee according to the fee scheduled as adopted by resolution of the City Council. This fee must be returned to the applicant if the permit is denied. The mooring/docking application must be reviewed by the Park Technical Committee and the Park Board before final submission to the City Council for approval.

A. Residents who have had mooring/docking plans approved the previous year, will be given first right to receive a permit during the present year of application. The renewal fee must be paid on or before March 15th to reserve this right.

B. Any new resident applications that are approved by the Park Technical Committee will be chosen in the following order:

1. Those persons who have been on a rank order waiting list from the previous year.

2. Those new approved applicants for the present year. A new applicant's rank order will be determined by lottery on April 15th.

901.030. Regulations for Mooring/Docking Plans.

A. A mooring plan must meet minimum requirements of all authorized State and Federal Agencies. In such event that there exists no clear requirements, the text of "Piloting, Seamanship, and Small Boat Handling" by Chapman will be used as a standard.

B. Docks. Docks, slips, or boat hoists will be constructed in such a fashion that they are structurally sound and aesthetically congruent with the environment. Each structure must clearly display the owner's name and phone number.

C. Location. Any mooring, dock, hoist, or slip must be located no closer than 100 feet from an adjacent mooring, dock, hoist or slip. There shall be no mooring, docks, hoists, or slips located on or in the water bounded by Upper 20th Street So., and 100 feet north of 19th Street South. Any encroachment of the area designated as "Swimming Beach" is prohibited.

901.040. Disputes. Any disputes that arise from the provisions of this ordinance shall be resolved by the Chair Person of the Park Board. If the dispute is not resolved to all parties satisfaction, a hearing may be requested before the City Council. A majority vote of the City Council will be required to resolve any such dispute.

901.050. Removal of Moorings, Docks, and Slips. All moorings, docks, slips, and hoists must be removed by non-mechanical means from the river by November 15 of each year or earlier if so notified by the Park Technical Committee to the owner of the mooring, dock, slip or other device. Any mooring, dock, slip or hoist that is placed on the shore during winter months must be firmly anchored to prevent floatation and placed so as to offer a minimal obstruction to the flow of flood water.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE ST. CROIX BEACH ORDAINS:

Section 1: Amendment.

1.01 Section 9.01 of Ordinance No. 80 and Section 9.01 of Ordinance No. 89 are hereby amended by deleting the same in their entirety and substituting therefore the following; amending same to read as follows:

"9.01 In order to assure orderly use of the city shoreland designated park land, the mooring of watercraft or the use of private boat docks, slips or hoists will be limited to residents of the City of Lake St. Croix Beach, and will require a permit to be issued by the City Council on an annual basis. Permits for a maximum of 35 watercraft will be given in any year. Permits may be issued for no more than 18 motorboats; the remaining watercraft shall all be sailboats.

a. A "motorboat" means any boat propelled exclusively by an internal combustion engine.

b. A "sailboat" means any boat intended to be propelled primarily by the wind. It may be equipped with a motor for auxiliary use.

c. Each permit will be subject to yearly review before renewal is considered. A person who receives a permit is entitled to moor or dock one watercraft registered in that person's name. Only one permit will be granted to any one household. Annual permit fees shall be established from time to time by Resolution of the City Council."

Section 2: Effective Date.

2.01 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.

It was mentioned that in 1983 the MN DNR staff may have thought that sailboats were less of an impact on the water than power boats. Understand that there are a variety of boat hulls, lengths and motor types. I made a comparison of the performance of two typical recreational boats.

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A J70 sailboat can reach 20 knots or 23 MPH.


A 20ft. Pontoon boat with a 40 hp motor can reach 16-25 MPH.

2. Use of the River – sailboat uses more water surface.

With a head wind, a sailboat will cover approximately twice as much area than a power boat traveling in a straight line in the same direction.

Sailing upwind requires consideration of several factors, including wind speed, wave conditions and level of comfort desired. In the example above, any of the three routes shown will lead to the same destination.
